Parents and Guest Code of Conduct and Responsibilities

The Orlando Outlaws Youth Football and Cheerleading (OOYFC) has implemented the following Parents and Guest Code of Conduct for the important message it holds about the proper role of supporting our children in sports. Parents (and explain to their guest) should read, understand and agree to the contents contained in this form prior to interacting with children participating at OOYFC sports.

Parent/Guest found guilty of improper conduct at any event/practice may be asked to leave the OOYFC facilities/host venue or, may face a suspension for multiple games or may face season forfeiture by OOYFC's Executive Board based on the severity of the infraction(s). Accused parties reserve the rights to a hearing based on the American Justice System.

Preamble

The essential elements of character-building and ethics in are embodied in the concept of sportsmanship and 6 core principles:

- Trustworthiness
- Respect
- Responsibility
- Fairness
- Caring and,
- Good Citizenship

The highest potential of sports is achieved when competition reflects these "six pillars of character"

I therefore agree:

- 1. I will not force a child to participate in sports. I understand that due to the limitation of roster space, my child may be reassigned to one of our associate programs at the head coach's discretion. I also understand there may be times that my child may not get in a game based on his/her abilities compared to the competition.
- 2. I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for the youth, not the adults.
- 3. I will inform the team mom of any physical disability or ailment the will affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
- 4. I will learn the rules of the game and the policies of the OOYFC.
- 5. I (and my guest) will be a positive role model for my child/team and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at ALL OOYFC activities.
- 6. I (and my guest) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, referee, coach, player, or parent such as booing or taunting; refusing to shake hands; or using profane language.
- 7. I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health or well being of the athletics.
- 8. I will teach my children/team to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.

- 9. I will demand that all children treat other players, coaches, officials, and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, color, sex, or ability.
- 10. I will teach the children/team that doing one's best is more important than winning, so that a child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a game or his/her performance.
- 11. I will praise the children for competing fairly and trying hard, and make the children feel like a winner every time.
- 12. I will never ridicule or yell at any child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- 13. I will emphasize skill development/ practices and how they benefit children over winning. I will also de-emphasize games, scores, and competition in the lower age groups.
- 14. I will promote the emotional and physical wellbeing of the athletes ahead of my personal desire I may have for my child/team to win.
- 15. I will respect the referees and their authority during the game. I will never question, discuss, or confront coaches at the game, and will take time to speak to the team mom at an agreed upon time and place.
- 16. I will demand a sports environment for my child/team that is free from drugs and alcohol and I will refrain from their use at all OOYFC events and practices.
- 17. I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.
- 18. I will do my fair share to support OOYFC's equipment fundraising activities by working concessions, working the entrance gate, and other fundraising activities.
- 19. No child will be mistreated because of lack of ability or skill level.
